Imagine Viewing the Cameras on your home, over the Internet, for \$1 a day!

How many of you would like to have cameras on your home that you can view live from anywhere over your high speed Internet connection? As I look out there, I think I saw almost every hand go up. I (well, not me personally, but my technicians) installed cameras on my home a few years ago and I have found the security cameras to be a great tool in 'policing' my teenage boys, checking to see who has been at my home and my wife has enjoyed the ability to see who has rang the doorbell, without answering the door.

But there are many other reasons for having security cameras on the home: Watching elderly parents when you can't be there, keeping an eye on the kids while at work, making sure the baby sitter is doing what they are supposed to be doing, seeing who is at the front door when the door bell rings, keeping an eye on the vacation house when you here in the Valley... and the list goes on.

Many people call us each month about installing cameras on their homes, and in some cases the cost has been prohibitive. What if I told you that we have a new camera system that requires little wiring (no, they are not wireless) you can see the cameras 24/7 over the Internet, you can receive emails if the cameras detect movement, and the entire system starts at \$999, and then costs about \$1 a day for the ability to see the cameras over the Internet. With our new web-based service you can view your cameras live 24/7 over any computer while connected to the Internet. This can be the computer in your home, at work, your mobile laptop or even over a hotel computer. The system works with Windows, Macintosh or Linux based operating systems.

The system will store your video clips on a server that can store the video for several days. If you wish to download stored video clips to your own computer for long term storage, it's all handled with just a few clicks of a mouse.

For those of you who have Internet enabled phones, you can even view your cameras right over your phone!

We offer this starter system for \$999 installed! Yes, installed, and financing is available from as low as \$35* a month.

To access your cameras live or to see stored video you will have an ongoing fee of \$1 per day (\$29.95 per month.*)

Setup of the system is straightforward and easy and you will have total control over the video, how you receive notices and your web based account.

If you want to add two additional cameras, maybe one to watch the front door or pool, we can do that.

Outdoor cameras can be added for as little as \$599 each or from \$19* a month.



We're excited about this new product and for our residential customers or small office customers who would like to have cameras to keep an eye on things when they are not around, this may be *'just the ticket!'*

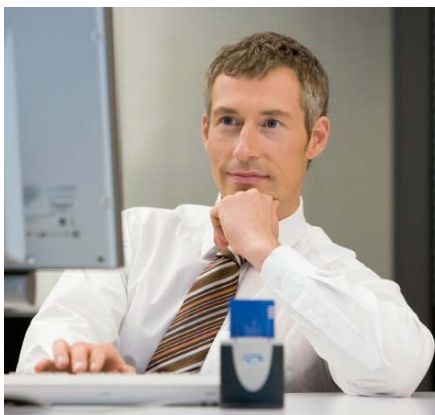

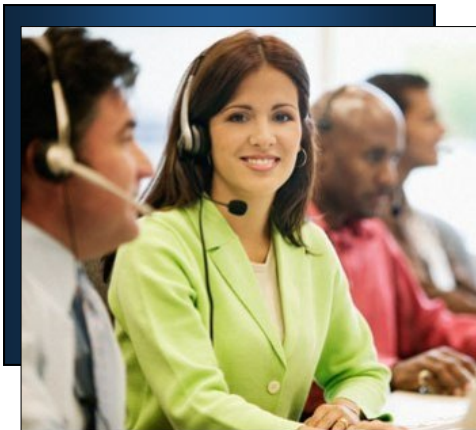
